**Student mobility for studies
from the University of Iringa (Uoi), Tanzania
to the Georg-August-Universität Göttingen (UGOE), Germany**

General overview:

The Georg-August-Universität Göttingen (UGOE) offers in the field of **Social and Cultural Anthropology** and **Museum Studies**:

- **1 staff mobility for teaching** (from Uoi to UGOE) for a duration of **up to 21 days**.

The mobility will be based on the museum cooperation between the University of Iringa/Iringa Boma – Regional Museum and Cultural Centre and the Ethnographic Collection at Goettingen Institute of Social and Cultural Anthropology. The grantee will be expected to teach museum studies and to participate in practical collection research and exhibition design projects, therefore applicants should be competent in these areas.

For teaching staff: A minimum of 8 hours of teaching per week at the host university has to be respected. Staff applicants should apply for the scholarship with an invitation letter from the host university.

Insurance:

All grant holders are insured by a central Group Insurance, which will be centrally organised by the Project Coordination Team upon successful nomination. The insurance costs (approximately 0,99 EUR per day) are deducted from the individual support.
